A Printed Sign Looks Stuck On. This Looks Built In.

Most lobby graphics are flat by nature: color on a surface, mounted to a wall, done. It's fast, it's affordable, and it looks exactly like what it is: a sign.

For a brand or an institution that's trying to make a first impression feel considered rather than adequate, flat isn't quite enough.

ClearDepth solves this differently. It's a clear layered architectural display element: the graphic sits inside the material itself, held off the wall on hardware that casts its own shadow.

The eye reads genuine physical depth, not printed color on a surface. The difference isn't subtle once you're standing in front of it: one reads as a sign, the other reads as architecture.



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Hardware That's Part of the Design

The standoffs holding a ClearDepth panel off the wall are part of why the finished piece reads as architecture instead of signage. That small gap between panel and wall does real work: it casts a shadow, it lets light move behind the piece, and it signals, at a glance, that this was installed rather than stuck on.

What that means in practice:

- Optical clarity and dimensional depth in every panel
- Stand-off, suspended, or layered mounting, chosen by application
- Custom shapes, thicknesses, and polished edge options
- Interior and select exterior configurations available

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Reads as fabricated, not printed.

The layered construction and stand-off mount both point the same direction: this piece was made for this wall, not ordered from a catalog and hung on it.

Built for the environment it's specified for.

Weather-resistant grades are available for interior and select exterior use, chosen for the specific project rather than assumed from a single default material.

One material, many presentations.

The same panel system covers a lobby logo, a directory, a donor wall, and room identification. One spec, one point of contact, one consistent read across an entire building instead of four different vendors and four different finishes.

Maintained the way it was built to be.

Cleanable with mild, non-abrasive methods only: no aggressive solvents required to keep the clarity that makes the whole system work.

Wherever an identity mark, a name, or a piece of information needs to feel built rather than printed, ClearDepth is built for it!



Lobby Logos

A lobby logo is the single most-seen graphic in a building. Held off the wall on hardware that casts its own shadow, it stops reading as a sign and starts reading as part of the architecture itself.



Directories

A directory built from layered panels updates section by section rather than getting replaced whole. It carries the same architectural read as everything else in the lobby, instead of looking like an afterthought bolted on near the elevators.



Donor Walls

A donor's name on a wall is a public gesture. The same layered-panel system that carries that name at architectural scale can also be sized down into something smaller and personal. A keepsake handed directly to the donor, built from the same material, holding the same quality of clarity and depth.



Room Identification

Room identification is often the most utilitarian signage in a building, and the easiest place for a project to downgrade material quality once the lobby budget is spent quietly. A layered panel system keeps that consistency intact all the way down the corridor, not just at the entrance.



ONE SYSTEM, EVERY SCALE

Everything that makes a lobby wall feel architectural: the clarity, the layered depth, the sense that a graphic was built into the material rather than printed on it. It scales down just as well as it scales up.



A small commemorative piece handed to someone rather than mounted on a wall. Same system, same read of quality, sized for a hand instead of a hallway.
