A custom dimensional identity and recognition system built from controlled depth, layering, and edge treatment. For your lobby identity, logos, and donor recognition that need to feel architectural, not applied.

Dimensional Layered Sign System

A Flat Logo Is a Decision Made Once. A Layered One Gets Noticed Every Time.

Most lobby identity work happens on one plane: a logo cut from a single panel, mounted flush to the wall, done. It reads clearly the first time someone sees it, and it also reads exactly as fast as it was made; a decision that was finished the day it was installed.

LayerForm starts from a different premise. The identity isn't cut from one surface; it's built from several: separate layers, each with its own depth, edge, and finish, set apart from the layer behind it. The gap between layers isn't incidental. It's what turns a shadow into a genuine third dimension, rather than a flat graphic implying one.

The result is a sign that keeps giving something back to a second look, not just a first one.



Depth Is a Design Decision, Not a Default

Every layer in a LayerForm piece is placed on purpose: how far it sits from the layer behind it, how its edge is finished, where the shadow lands once the light hits it. None of that is left to whatever the material happens to do on its own. It's specified, the same way a typeface or a color is specified.

That's the line between a genuinely dimensional identity piece and a flat graphic with a shadow added afterward to suggest depth it doesn't actually have. One is built. The other is implied.

What that means in practice:

- Multi-layer dimensional construction, not a single printed plane
- Custom edge treatment and finish, layer by layer
- Interior and exterior configurations available
- Scales from a small interior wordmark to a freestanding exterior identity piece without changing the underlying system

Genuine dimension, not a printed illusion of it.

A photograph of a lobby can flatten almost anything into looking dimensional. Standing in front of it is the real test, and a LayerForm piece is built to pass that test. Because the depth is physically there, layer to layer, not painted on to read that way in a rendering.

One identity, finished the same way at every scale.

The same layered approach that anchors a donor wall at the far end of a lobby also carries a small reception wordmark near the front desk. One system, one point of accountability, rather than a different vendor and a different construction method for every scale of sign in the building.

Finished the way the space around it is finished.

Painted, metallic, transparent, wood-look, matte, and gloss options can be mixed across layers within a single piece. So, the sign is finished to match the interior it's going into, not selected from whatever finish happened to be available for that material.

Specified for where it's actually going.

Interior and exterior configurations are both available, with mounting method (stand-off, stud, rail, concealed, or mechanical) chosen by application rather than defaulted to whatever's easiest to install.

Wherever an identity or a name deserves to stand off the wall instead of sitting flush against it, LayerForm is built for it.



Donor Recognition

A name on a flat plaque says thanks once, in passing. A layered, dimensional recognition piece says the organization actually meant it. Enough to build something with genuine presence instead of ordering the least expensive version of gratitude.



Dimensional Logos

A logo cut from one panel is a shape. A logo built from several layers, each catching light differently, is closer to a piece of the building itself: identity with enough physical presence that it doesn't need a caption explaining what it is.



Reception Signs

The reception wall is the one surface almost every visitor looks at, whether or not they mean to. Depth gives their eyes somewhere to land beyond a flat mark and a company name.



Lobby Signs

The same layered system that anchors an interior identity wall carries just as well to the point where a visitor first encounters the brand. Visible branding, before they've even reached the lobby that it's naming.
